<p>Introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brief introduction by the participants of the meeting. • CP sub cluster and PDMA welcome all the participants of the meeting. 	
<p>Review of last meeting minutes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PDMA shared that 3 deaths reported and 29 houses fully and 3,147 houses partially damaged due to recent rains and flooding in KP. It was also shared that report of damages is available on PDMA websites. The assessment of damages in districts has been compiled by getting information from DCOs and humanitarian organizations. • It was also shared by PDMA that cook food, 100 tents and food packages have been provided to the affectees of recent rains and flooding in Nowshera. • CP sub Cluster shared that SPADO has already been contacted for sharing MRE materials with Khwendo Kor (KK) and CP sub-cluster. SPADO shared that they are in contact with KK and will share MRE material with them and will train their staff as well. • CP sub-cluster was informed about the meeting of district working group held on 11th Sept 2012 in PDMA office, Peshawar. • SOPs on separated and un-accompanied children have been signed by PDMA and sent to NDMA for further action. • The issue of NOC from district authorities for CP interventions at district level was discussed in an HRT meeting and it was shared that it is an issue of all clusters and OCHA agreed to call a separate meeting of all the cluster leads with DG PDMA to sort 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SPADO will share the MRE material with KK and CP sub cluster • All cluster partners were requested to share if they are facing an NOC related concerns at district level, so that it

<p>Updates on HOP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CP sub cluster shared that HOP revision is almost final and will be presented to HCT tomorrow for approval. It was also shared that strategy document is revised but no change made in the partner's projects. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cluster and partners will be updated by OCHA on HOP
<p>CP working groups at district level:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It was shared by CP sub cluster and IRC Protection cluster co-lead that district protection working group meeting held in Peshawar on 11 Sept 2012. The focal persons of district working groups were oriented on TORs of district working group and they came up with certain comments after thorough review that will be incorporated. It was also agreed that if there is any issue that cannot be handled/solved at district level, will be referred to provincial cluster to resolve. • IRC Protection cluster co-lead shared that they have some funding available for capacity building district focal persons that will be utilized for their training. The training package will include protection, CP and GBV. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IRC protection cluster co-lead will share revised TORs with district focal persons. • IRC protection cluster co-lead will share minutes of district working group meeting with provincial protection, child protection and GBV sub-clusters.
<p>Updates, Issues, Challenges and Gaps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Partners of CP sub-cluster again raised their concerns related to the demands of district authorities for seeking a separate NOC from the district authorities. • On the point of funding constraints, the IRC Protection cluster co-lead shared that ERF fund was given only to 4 life-saving clusters but unfortunately protection is not part of the call. Protection cluster at the national level advocated for its inclusion in the ERF call but unfortunately that was not successful. • Communication messages, on Risk Education (RE), developed in the MRE working group are available and IOM will be 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PDMA will update cluster regarding NOC issue in next cluster meeting. • IOM will be invited in the next cluster meeting

<p>requested to on air those messages in the affected areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Save the children informed that they are planning 30 more CFSs for IDP children in Peshawar valley. It was also shared that health issues with IDP children were reported from the field and has been referred to different service providers. 	
<p>Child protection policy on Safe guarding child protection in disasters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Save the children shared that child protection policy (Safe guarding child protection in disaster) went through same level of consultation and discussion as the SOPs on separated and unaccompanied children and was presented to NDMA and PDMA but still it has not been signed. PDMA was requested to look for the policy, get it sign and send back to NDMA for final approval. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PDMA will look into the matter and update the cluster in next meeting
<p>Return Monitoring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CP sub cluster shared that return of IDPs to South Waziristan and Kuram agency is on-going but we have not received any report on monitoring of child protection issues specifically during return. It was agreed that District Protection Working Group will form a group of child protection monitors who will monitor child protection issues during return and report back to the cluster. It was also shared that return from D.I.Khan to South Waziristan is planned on 24th Sept 2012 and to Kuram on 14th Sept 2012. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> District working groups will form team of child protection monitors and will share reports of issues/ concerns with cluster.
<p>AOB:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CP sub cluster informed that CPiE evaluation team of UNICEF is in Pakistan and were supposed to meet with cluster members at KPK but could not make it possible due to prevailing security situation. It was also shared by CP sub cluster that CPiE resource kit, in 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">
