<p>Contingency Planning (monsoon 2012)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cluster Coordinator discussed the Contingency Plan and appreciated the organization those share their material detail and requested the remaining one to share their stock position. He also shared the excel sheets for contingency plan. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cluster Coordinator will share the soft copy of excel sheet before the 1st June 2012 COB. All the organizations will share the filled sheets for contingency planning before 4th June 2012
<p>Progress update for emergency response & Early Recovery</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All the members shared the progress updates regarding the emergency response and early recovery. UNICEF is adopted 610 schools for welcome to school campaign which comprises activities like provision of school supplies, teachers training, minor repair, establishment of TIJs, establishment of Alternate Learning Spaces etc. in FATA. SC has established 16 TLC with the enrolment of 2,067 children (988 boys & 1088 girls). Total enrolment in 12 camp schools in Jalozai with UNICEF support reached to 4,428 children including 1,982 girls with 107 teachers (Female: 54). IRC registered total 1,958 students (562 girls) and 34 teachers (17 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> SC will mainstream the TLC children into government schools after June 2012

<p>females) attending its 7 camp schools through funding by SV.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PADO started a UNAID funded project focusing on community based school in SWAT. Target number of children is 1500 benefiting from this project. Currently 500 children were enrolled during this year. 	
<p>Presentation on Jalozai camp visit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A group of four organizations visited the Jalozai camp schools. They visit 5 schools including higher secondary school. • Generally following are the observations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Attendance rate is about 50 % as compared to the actual enrolment. ○ Lacks the learning material particular text books ○ Lack of school supplies. ○ Conditions of tents are dilapidated in some schools. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Group will present their finding (power point presentation) in a next meeting without mentioning the name of any organization. • Only observation & suggestive measures will be shared. • UNICEF will ensure the school supplies. • Issue of text book will discuss in a meeting with education department.
