<p><b>Introduction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Brief introduction by the participants of the meeting.</li> <li>CP Sub-Cluster and PDMA welcomed all the participants of the meeting.</li> <li>Agenda points of the meeting were reviewed and all participants were agreed to the suggested agenda of the meeting.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Review of last meeting minutes</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CP Sub-Cluster have coordinated with SPADO in respect of MRE material and it was shared that the soft copy of material is available with SPADO and CP Sub-Cluster will share it with members after getting it from SPADO. It was also suggested that an orientation session can be arranged in the CP Sub-Cluster meeting on MRE for the cluster members. SPADO will also be contacted to share the data regarding the affected areas of KP and FATA due to mines and affected children as well.</li> <li>Mostly cluster members informed that revised TORs for District Working Group have not been shared by IRC. Hayat Foundation shared that they have received the revised TORs and it will be forwarded to all cluster members of Child Protection.</li> <li>Due to non-presence of IVAP in the cluster meeting, factsheet about detail of child protection related information collected in the survey was not presented in the cluster meeting.</li> <li>CP Sub-Cluster informed the forum that concerns regarding limited time for ERF proposals submission have been raised with national cluster and it was agreed in the discussion to give maximum time for proposal submission, so that quality proposals can be submitted. <p><b>CPRA working group updates:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CP Sub-Cluster briefed the forum about the progress made by CPRA working group. It was shared that orientation sessions on CPRA has been completed, and work plan to conduct CPRA for IDPs in Jalozai and host communities of Peshawar valley has been finalized. It was also shared that by next week CPRA working group will finalize the sampling for CPRA both in and off camp and training of enumerators on CPRA tools is planned on 13 and 14 Dec 2012 in PDMA office.</li> <li>• It was also shared that data collection process is planned to be conducted from 18 to 2, Dec 2012 in Jalozai and off camp both simultaneously.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Updates on DPWGs trainings:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CP Sub-Cluster informed the forum that training of District Protection Working Group (DPWGs) have been conducted in District Dir, Kohat and Swat, but due to security issues training in District D.I.Khan and Tank is still pending and will be held after security clearance. It was also shared that during the above mentioned trainings Child Protection in Emergencies (CPiE) and Minimum standards were covered by Child Protection Cluster Coordinator. At the end six months work plans were also developed where mostly child protection issues have been highlighted. All partners were asked to coordinate at the district level with DPWGs and participate in their meetings.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DPWGs will keep PDMA and Child Protection Commission in loop for coordination at the district level.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updates on CP help desks for return in Kurram and South Waziristan. (CPU-FATA):</li> <li>• Provincial Coordinator of Child Protection Wing, FATA briefed the forum</li> </ul>	

<p>regarding CP help desks for return in Kurram and South Waziristan agencies. It was shared, that due to operation in SWA, some 10,025 families were displaced and forced to live in camps and with host communities in Tank and D.I.Khan. The return process started in 2010 and Child Protection Unit of SWA established Child Help Desk for identification, registration of vulnerable children and to assess them according to their protective needs, i.e. shelter, food, health, education, legal, cognitive, emotional and evolving capacities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It was also shared that Social Sectors Departments FATA, with the help of field staff at Agency level, has established 3 Child Help Desks to provide services to vulnerable children and women of returnee’s families, who went back during the return process from April 25 to 28, July 16 to 19 and September 24 to 26, 2012. The Help Desks were established at the points of registration and return in D.I.Khan and Tank. During these return processes 1,185 cases of vulnerable children and women were identified and referred to various service providers working in D.I.Khan, Tank and SWA for providing them with the required services.</li> <li>• The concern was raised by Child Protection Wing, FATA that progress of CP interventions being carried out in FATA is not being shared with CPW, so the forum agreed to share their progress reports with the CPW, FATA.</li> <li>• It was also shared by CPW- FATA that first ever in Pakistan “<b>FATA Child Protection Policy</b>” has been developed by the FATA Secretariat and got approved by Governor Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, on January 10, 2012. The policy enumerates various measures and steps whereby the children of FATA would have a protective and friendly environment. Through the policy FATA Secretariat assured that it will make all efforts for extending and implementing all federal laws and international protocols on child rights protection.</li> <li>• The forum suggested that an orientation session should be organized on CP policy of FATA in early January 2013 for all CP Sub-Cluster members. Save the Children offered to support in logistic arrangements for this orientation session on Child Protection Policy of FATA.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All CP sub cluster partners working in FATA will share the progress report of their interventions with CP wing FATA. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CP Sub-Cluster shared that in HRT meeting all clusters of KP/ FATA have been informed about the refresher training on coordination which is planned on 13th Dec 2012 in WFP office and training will be conducted by Ms. Joe Reed, International consultant, Acted. So CP Sub-Cluster will share two nominations for the said training with OCHA.</li> <li>• CP Sub-Cluster also informed that in last HRT meeting it was decided to revise HOP 2012 for 2013 as the IDP population figures are now changed. So it was decided to revise HOP on the basis of revised caseload, planning and priorities. In HRT meeting it was decided that OCHA will arrange a meeting with DGs of PDMA and FDMA and all stakeholders to discuss planning for HOP revision. In the said meeting the NOC issue, i.e. requirement of NOC from line departments instead of PDMA NOC will also be discussed.</li> <li>• PDMA shared that PDMA Child Protection desk is planning to arrange training workshop on Child Protection in Emergencies on 17-19 Dec 2012 for capacity building of line departments, PDMA staff and members of local NGOs. Training workshop will also include development of training manuals, service mapping, key messages development, translate key messages into local languages and disseminations. This training workshop will be followed by a consultative workshop which will be attended by CP stakeholders.</li> <li>• CP Sub-Cluster shared that World Vision project in Jalozai in, where 10 CFSs were functional, have been closed in November 2012. These CFSs have been handed over to PDMA who may not be able to continue after December. It was suggested that UNICEF discuss it internally and let the cluster know if they can take over these CFSs and continue along with their other CFSs in the camp. PDMA shared that UNFPA is onboard and discussion is underway to take over the responsibilities of the Women Spaces.</li> <li>• UNICEF shared that current CP activities in Jalozai will be continued till March 2013 and in district Hangu and Togh Sarai till May 2013.
