SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

DISCUSSION POINTS	ACTIONS REQUIRED (By WHO&WHEN)
<p>Recitation from Holy Quran and Introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meeting was started with recitation from Holy Quran. And then brief introduction was held by all participants. 	
<p>Review of action points from pervious minutes of the meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Education cluster emphasized that each member of Education cluster should share their progress reports of their interventions with relevant education department in KP and FATA. If any organization is facing some issues while coordinating with education line department then organization should liaise with education cluster and cluster will make follow up. UNICEF informed the forum that the contract of transportation of school supplies is expired to provide school supplies from national office to relevant organizations. UNICEF is in process of re-contract, as the new contract of transportation is finalized the provision of school supplies would be resumed. Education cluster informed the forum that due to cut of food ration to IDP families in Jalozai by WFP, affected the attendance of children in schools of IRC and Muslim Aid in Jalozai. The cluster has taken up the issue with WFP and OCHA and it was shared with cluster by WFP and OCHA that Govt. is taking 150 metric ton food for IDPs which will normalize the situation. IRC shared that in response of NOC request to FDMA for education intervention in Mohmand agency, the political agent have allowed for assessment and location identification for education interventions which is in process. The cluster requested the IRC to share the list of camp schools of Jalozai in which the WASH facilities are in terrible condition and dangerous to use by children, so that issue can be taken up 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> IRC will share the list of camp schools of Jalozai with UNICEF to take up the issue with WASH section.

<p>with UNICEF WASH section.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Education cluster shared that the concept note to implement article 25-A has not been shared by Khwendo Kor as decided in the previous cluster meeting, so when it will be shared with cluster the way forward will be decided. 	
<p>HOP 2013 Strategies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Education cluster shared that OCHA has shared the latest figures of IDP and expected return, according to which 97000 families are expected to be returned in 2013. The cluster have been shared that target for HOP 2013 is decided as 25% for off camp and 50% for in camp. So total cluster target caseload is 126,015 children in HOP 2013 for sustaining current relief and new activities. Cluster also shared that new proposals have been discouraged and priority is given to HOP 2012 proposals as they haven't received any funds in 2012. • Cluster also emphasised on SMART indicators while revising the proposals according to new caseload and priorities. Cluster requested the partners to give their input on HOP 2013 strategy document which was submitted to OCHA for their comments so that it can be further in lined with current educational needs of IDP children. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Education cluster will share HOP 2013 strategy document and members will give their input to improve it further
<p>Updates on ERAF:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cluster informed the forum on Early Recovery Assistance Framework (ERAF) and their proposals. It was informed that govt. has agreed to endorse the 1st phase of ERAF and FDMA suggested to revise the projects according to budget agreed which was 1/3 of total budget of all projects submitted earlier. On the base of guideline all the ERAF projects owners revised their projects and activities, beneficiaries and budget accordingly. 	<p>All the project Owner of ERAF will consider the time frame related to the NOC process and no project should be less than 9 months because initially three months can be consumed on NOC process.</p>

<p>Progress, Issues, Challenges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Progress updates by cluster members will be shared by email with cluster. • IRC shared that notification regarding the appearance of IDP children enrolled in camp schools in the board examination has been issued by ESR unit, Department of Education, KP. Notification copy will be shared with cluster to disseminate within cluster members to use it for appearance of IDP enrolled children in board exams. • IRC also share the text books will be provided by KP- education department a letter will share for further proceeding. • Muslim Aid shared that Education walk is planned on 18 Feb 2013 in Jalozai, and all education cluster members are invited to participate in the event. • It was shared by education partners working in Jalozai that NFIs distribution among IDP children enrolled in camp schools is planned on 19,20 & 21 Feb 2013. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Progress updates by cluster members will be shared by email with cluster. • Cluster will share the copy of notification issued by Education department KP to wave off the examination fee for IDP children studying in camp and off camps to appear in board exams.
<p>AOB:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher's absenteeism from schools is highlighted by partners in the cluster meeting. Bridge organization informed that software for record keeping and assessment of teacher's absenteeism has been developed which can be presented in cluster meeting for sharing and feedback. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bridge organization will give presentation regarding the software for assessing teacher's absenteeism in next cluster meeting.
