

## WHO Emergency Humanitarian Program Situation Report

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and FATA

Week 9

Date: February 26-March 03, 2012

### 1. Situation around IDP hosting districts

#### A. "New Durrani" IDP camp, Kurram Agency

WHO requested partners to submit health project proposals for provision of health care services in New Durrani camp. BARAN, EHSAR Foundation, NATPOW, MIHO, NCHD and Bright Future Organization submitted their project proposals for the provision of services in New Durrani IDP camp. These proposals are in reviewing process.

#### B. "Togh Sarai" IDP camp, Hangu district

Current IDP population is 1188 families or 7128 individuals. Visit was conducted to IDP camp Togh Sarai to check health and environmental health situation and it was observed that both health and EH services were up to mark and normal. No major outbreak or alerts received this week. In addition, WHO DEWS report that acute respiratory infections are still the highest cause of morbidity (19% or 115 cases) of total of 606 consultations (15% decrease); other acute diarrhoea (8% or 47 cases); skin infection (3% or 8 cases).

DEWS refresher training of DoH staff and Health partners working in District Hangu has been conducted on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2012. The participants of the training were health professionals including Medical Officers, LHVs, Male/Female Medical Technicians, Dispensers, and other paramedics belonging to different government health facilities. Total participants for DEWS training were 58 with breakup of 3 Doctors, 10 LHV's, 18 Male Medical technicians (MT), 1 Female MT and 2 Nurses. From health partners 3 candidates participated from MDM-F, 4 from CERD (working in Togh Saray IDP Camp), 4 from RID (WASH partner in IDP Camp) and 1 from PDH working in Refugee camps.

#### C. Overview of health facility situation in Tank district

There are 33 health facilities catering for 360,000 people with DHQ as the key health facility. WHO took part in the coordination meeting on review the overall health problems and issues regarding PEI campaigns. A meeting was held with ICRC and UNFPA. MDM plans to run BHU Ranwal and BHU Gara Baloch. Surveillance and monitoring visits were conducted at BHU Shah Alam, Ranwal, Kot Alladad, Cheena, Kot Musa, CD DaudKhel, Shadi Khel (Maghzai) and DHQ hospital. EPI centres were visited. Malaria control supervisors advised to collect certain slides each week on a mandatory basis. 8 health facilities were visited by WHO, including EDOH, and improvement on eDEWS reporting observed.

#### D. Situation in D I Khan district

29 health facilities report eDEWS to WHO. A total of 8,613 consultations were provided. ARI remained major cause of morbidity (22.79 %), diarrhea (7.71%), scabies (3.32 %) and malaria (3.08 %). A total of 08 alerts were received and responded, including measles & neonatal tetanus.

WHO took part in the divisional pre-campaign meeting for upcoming SNID together with UNICEF. Similar micro planning for Mother & Child Week celebrated in April was conducted. WHO participated in first two days Annual Review / Audit of EPI (Routine Immunization Coverage) in district D I Khan upon request of Provincial EPI Cell as member of the Review Panel along with UNICEF. WHO met with SAHARA & SDO NGOs interested in providing PHC & MNCH services to the IDPs of SWA. They were advised to prepare proposals as there is an expressed need for further coverage and expansion of health services by interested health cluster organizations.

WHO monitors the situation of the nutrition stabilization center at DHQ D I Khan. In addition, WHO plans to finalize reconstruction of 5 health facilities.

WHO conducted assessment of civil WASH infrastructure improvement work of 5 identified health facilities in D I Khan including Type-D Hospital Pahar Pur, CD Yarik, BHU Jandi Babar, Police Hospital, and CD Muslim Bazar.

#### **E. Situation in “Jalozai” IDP camp, Nowshera district**

A total of 60313 IDP’s are living in Jalozai IDP’s Camp. Due to on going armed forces operation in Bara Tehsil of Khyber Agency, the recent influx of Shalobar tribe from 20<sup>th</sup> January 2012 till 20<sup>th</sup> February 2012 shows that 27159 individuals (6358 families) have been registered. Only 1770 tents have been issued till now to the new IDP’s families in Jalozai Camp, whereas the no of registered families is 6358.

Majority of the families has moved to local areas of Nowshera/Peshawar/other adjoining districts. The population has been settled in vacant places of the existing six phases of the camp by giving them tents. The registration is under process and about 10,000 families of some more tribes (Malak din Khel, Aka Khel, Kamar khel and stori khel) are expected to arrive in Jalozai Camp in the coming days. A new phase is being established for the newly displaced IDP’s by PDMA.

WHO assists in health care provision through support to Merlin and CAMP. Merlin and CERD provide MCH services with the support of UNICEF. WASH services are provided by HRDS and SSD (UNICEF partners).

The camp is regularly visited by WHO teams of Public Health Officer, Environmental Health Engineer and Pharmacist. Two cases of suspected measles (living off camp/in District Peshawar), one Leishmaniasis and one AFP case were reported from the camp, investigated and responded by WHO.

An increase was observed in scabies cases in phase 3 among the recent influx families by CAMP. Immediate response provided by WHO in coordination with health promotion teams of Merlin and CAMP.

Assessment of Jalozai IDP’s Camp health facilities is planned by WHO to assess the health delivery system in the camp. Camp Coordination Meeting of Jalozai IDP’s Camp co–chaired by PDMA and UNHCR was attended by WHO. It was decided that Merlin would sign/stamp the token of recent influx families before sending them for verification. This will ensure that all IDP children and females get vaccinated before entering the camp/off camp locations. WHO paid a monitoring visit to Merlin J3 health post..

#### **F. Situation in Kohat district**

35 out of 43 health facilities reported DEWs. WHO completed construction of the warehouse in LMH hospital. MDM-F requested WHO for support in training material for IMNCI training for DoH.

#### **eDEWS:**

#### **KPK DEWS:**

316 reports were received reporting 81,453 patient consultations in 14 districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province. Acute respiratory infections are the highest cause of morbidity (30% or 24,122 cases) showing 1% increase; acute diarrhoea (6% or 4,477 cases); skin infection (3% or 2,168 cases); suspected malaria (1% or 1,000 cases).

#### **FATA DEWS:**

32 reports were received reporting 7,141 patient consultations in 2 agencies of FATA. Acute respiratory infections are the highest cause of morbidity (30% or 2,139 cases) showing 9% decrease; acute diarrhoea (6% or 428 cases); skin infection (4% or 271 cases); suspected malaria (3% or 188 cases).

### **Alerts:**

A total of 80 alerts and 4 outbreaks were received. Out of 80 alerts 63 were suspected measles, 7 - NNT, 8 - leishmaniasis, 1 each for AFP and AWD cases. All reported cases were responded with proper case definition and awareness sessions were conducted in the community.

### **ARI Centers:**

A total of 3,486 ARI cases were reported from ARI centers. ARI consultations were decreased as compared to last weeks due to 5 ARI centers out of 14 were closed and remaining ARI centers propose closing date is 10th march, 2012.

### **HEPR / DENGUE:**

Hospital Coordinator along with DEWS Coordinator KPK participated in Dengue International Conference held in Lahore from 27-29 February. A workshop was organized on implementation strategy and action plan for dengue prevention and control program on 3rd March in Islamabad hotel. Participants included EDO Health from 8 high risk districts for dengue, DG health, Secretaries of various departments and developmental partners including UNICEF, WHO and GIZ.

### **Essential Medicines:**

- A total of 6 coordination meetings held with different stake holders including EDOHs, MS and DCO at Peshawar, D.I. Khan, Swat Charsadda and Dir Lower in which distribution of EM, Provision of EM for IDPs, storage of medicines and training of LSS were discussed respectively.
- A total of 5 monitoring and 1 follow up visits were performed in districts D.I. Khan, Dir Lower, Charsadda and Kohat. Gaps regarding irrational use, storage of essential medicines, inventory control, record keeping and stock outs identified generally. Required essential medicines provided as per need at visited health facilities. Stock register also provided to stabilization centre at DHQH, Charsadda.
- A total of 5 training sessions were conducted in district Kohat, D.I. Khan, Dir Lower and Charsadda in which total of 10 participants trained on rational use of medicines, good pharmaceutical storage practices, good dispensing practices, record keeping and LSS.
- WHO responded 4 leishmaniasis, 13 measles allerts at Kohat, D.I. Khan and Dir Lower by providing EM support and health sessions. EM provided to DHQH, Nowshera in response to Bomb blast victims.
- SFD equipment supplied to Saidu Group of Teaching Hospital at Swat. WHO provided assistance to MSF in Kohat. CERD in Togh Saray, Hangu, received Ciprofloxacin 500mg=300, Ciprofloxacin 200mg=1100, metronidazole 400mg tab=294, zinc sulphate 20mg tab=3800, Cotrimaxazole 480mg tab=1500, Doxycycline tab=700.
- To fill the gap of deficient essential medicines, WHO supplied assorted medicines to BHU Mayar (Syrup Diphenhydramine HCl 240ml =120 and 120ml =72, Permethrine lotion = 50), THQ hospital Samar Bagh Dir Lower (Syrup Diphenhydramine 240ml = 240, 120ml = 72 and Permethrine lotion = 100), ARI treatment Center Chakdara Dir Lower (Syrup Diphenhydramine HCl 240ml =144, Syrup Paracetamol =174, Suspension Amoxicilline 125mg/ml = 34, syrup pincalline 125ml = 12, syrup sulbutamol = 70, Tab Amoxicillin 250mg = 2000, Tab Erythromycin 250mg = 200 and Syrup Chlorophenormine maleate 120ml = 120) and RHC Talash Dir Lower (Cotton Bandages = 150 pcs and Spirit 60 ml bottles = 50).
- IDPs camp Jalozai: Assessment of health facilities at Jalozai camp completed. Some gaps regarding inventory management found at the facilities. Gaps filled by providing essential medicines by Merlin from WHO supplied medicines. Two on job training provided on Inventory management.

- 10 Meglumine Injection and medicines including analgesic syrups provided to Merlin for Jalozei Camp.
- **FATA:** Total three coordination meetings held with MS AHQ Ghallane Mohmand agency, ASU PPHI Khyber agency and DHIS Manager DHS FATA in which nominations for LSS training, Leishmaniasis outbreak situation, its prevention & control and overall Leishmaniasis cases in Khyber agency discussed respectively.
- Visits have been made to BHU Lakkaro (FPHC supported), warehouses at AHQ Ghallane and DHS FATA in which essential medicines availability, storage practices, rational use of medicines, return of diuretics to avoid underuse, dosage and administration of Zanamavir and Tiotropium bromide, presence of permethrin for residual spray and LSS update discussed respectively thereby emphasizing best use of available resources.
- Essential medicines provided to FPHC supporting two BHUs and one mobile hospital in IDPs return area Mohmand agency, AS Kurram agency supporting New Durrani IDPs camp, SO Bajour agency and PPHI for BHUs in FATA include one EH package, 2900 anti allergic syrups, 1476 nasal decongestant syrups, 2200 Glucosamine tablets and 7120 Multivitamins capsules respectively.
- **RAHA:** In coordination meeting with EDO Health, MS DHQH & Pharmacist DHQH Haripur and Abbott Abad were briefed on LSS refresh training & implementation. ARI package & current EM states was also briefed.
- EDOH Haripur was visited and monitored. On job training on goods storage practices & safe disposal of expired medicines conducted for warehouse staff.

#### **WASH:**

- WHO Team District Nowshera conducted rapid camp assessment of the WASH facilities in view of the fresh IDPs influx in the camp. 6,358 new IDP families including 27,159 individuals have been registered in the Jalozei IDP camp Nowshera. WASH services to the new influx are provided by HRDS and SSD (UNICEF IPs).
- EH Engineer WHO Nowshera held meeting with WASH partners in Jalozei Camp. Due to current influx of new IDPs in the camp the burden for WASH services has increased. To improve the capacity of the WASH Partners on water quality monitoring EH Engineer WHO provided two Wegtech kits one each to SSD and HRDS. EH Engineer also demonstrated the use Wegtech kit for water quality monitoring.
- WHO team visited all the Health facilities in the Jalozei IDP camp including J1, J2, J3 of Merlin and CAMP organization. Detail assessments of the Health facilities done.
- EDO-H, District Kohat requested for in time Vector Control activities in the District. EHA-Team is in close coordination with Malaria control person of the district and will soon identify the high risk areas of the district and request HUB for permission of possible actions.
- WHO EH unit KPK/FATA completed WASH assessment of 7 identified health facilities for Rehabilitation and Reconstruction work in district Bunir.
- Assessment of Health facilities from Mehmand, Khyber, DI Khan, Kohat and Hangu completed for repair and reconstruction included in Saudi Fund for Development.
- WHO EH Team FATA hold a coordination meeting with Agency Surgeon Mohmand Agency and coordinator FPHC, health care waste equipments will be provided by WHO to BHU Muhabat Gat for improved management of infectious waste in the health facility.
- WHO EH team coordinated with XEN PHED and TMO for water supply of HFs included in the SFD improvement works. Also informed them about installation of color comparators with already installed chlorinators.
- Coordination meeting conducted with EDOH, EPI coordinator, National program, MS Smarbagh, MS DHQ, staff of the BHU Tormang, RHC Mayar, AR Timar Camp, MCH Khal, RHC Talash, THQ Chakdara, ARI Centre Chakdara and TMA Chief officer for Leishmaniasis, measles Alerts response, TMA lab equipments recently provided and monitoring visits to the area reporting alerts/outbreaks.
- Coordination meeting held with the contractor working under ECHO fund in DHQ and LMH hospital in District Kohat, EHA-Team directed the contractor to functionalize the newly dug bore-well in LMH Hospital. But there is still delay in operations from their side.
- Coordination meeting conducted with EDO-H, District Kohat regarding the inauguration of newly

constructed warehouse by WHO in LMH hospital, District Kohat. EDO-H was informed regarding the arrangements for the ceremony. There are some items still waited to set the date for the ceremony.

- Coordination meeting held with EDO Health focal person to resolve pending issues.
- A coordination meeting was held on 2nd March, 2012 with TMO Havalian District Abbottabad. The Tehsil Administrator appreciated WHO contribution towards water Quality improvement and requested for additional support in chlorination and disinfection of overhead water tanks.
- EH Engineer WHO visited city hospital Peshawar and inspected the ongoing progress of maintenance works along with the Hospital maintenance committee. Meeting was also held with contractor regarding the completion of the project. Contractor requested for the award of completion certificate which will be provided after the visit of the team from the Health department and incase of their satisfaction on completed work.
- EH Engineer WHO visited Lady reading Hospital meeting was held with the Director causality regarding the progress work. Paint work and electrification work is in progress.60% of the work is completed in Causality LRH.
- Construction of Warehouse at DHQ hospital Timargara is still pending and MS of DHQ Timargara Repeatedly ask updates.
- Monitoring visit to THQ Matta and ARI centre of Merlin, WHO funded in THQ Matta was done in order ensure weather infection control process is in place.
- WHO EH team visited to BHU Lakarro and BHU Baro khail Mohmand Agency.
- Construction work of WHO ware houses in CH Jamrud and AHQ Ghalanai are almost completed, logistics wracks fixation are pending; but construction of AHQ Khaar ware house has not yet started.
- Visited MM Teaching Hospital D.I.Khan for final inspection of WASH improvement works by Mehmand Construction Limited.
- WHO Team visited DHQ Timargara, THQ Samarbagh, THQ Chakdara, ARI Centre Chakdara, RHC Talash, RHC Mayar, BHU Tormang and MCH Khal for routine monitoring and Alerts Response,.
- Monitoring and work check visits paid to civil work sites in District Kohat but work is still pending in spite of the continuous reminder to the contractor.
- 9 measles and tetanus Alerts responded in areas of Chungi, Arra Road, and Wazir Abad, Pusha Pul, Bannu Road (DI Khan), village Koalano Cham Asband Bazaar, village Dalgram Maidan, village Anderay and village Manogay U.C Koto, village Faratta UC Miskanay Dir Lower and village Gal Payen Khagram, Village Munjafar, UC Miskanay, Tehsil Samar Bagh (Dir upper), CD Jungle Khel, Village Jungle Khel, Union Council Urban III, District Kohat. All precautionary measures and preventive protocol given for the containment of the disease. Active surveillance done in the area and no more case found in the neighbourhood.
- All the mentioned alerts/outbreaks were jointly responded by DoH & WHO EHA Team along EPI Vaccinators. Outreach Immunization activities were conducted in each affected areas with all available antigens. Health & Hygiene sessions conducted, Camp In charge and concerned Surveillance Officer Bajour Agency was also informed for active surveillance and request the RBM for residual spray before the favourable season for vector breeding and transmission in the area.
- WHO EH unit KPK/FATA collected 17 water samples from different areas in District Kohat, DI Khan and Shangla. 35% of the samples were found faecally contaminated. In response WHO in collaboration with District TMAs and PHED initiated remedial measure by providing aqua tabs, hygiene kits and disinfection of the main community water storage tanks.
- Pre-positioning of contingency stock was made in flood and conflict affected district of KPK/FATA for control and prevention of communicable disease. In epidemiological week 9 WHO distributed 620 hand washing soaps, 10200 aqua tabs, 30 hygiene kits, 400 sets of IEC material and 200 ITNs in response to Alert reported and responded in District Dir Upper, DI Khan, abbotabad, Kohat and Khyber Agency.
- Two wegtech kits were provided to Jalojai camp WASH partners for regular water quality monitoring in the camp.
- An On job training session was organized by WHO EH team for sensitization of health staff from THQ Samarbagh, RHC Mayar, BHU Tormang and MCH Khal on safe disposal of health care waste and infection control in health care sittings.
- WHO EH team conducted an on job session conducted to 10 health care and health promoters in the HFs.

- Detail presentation on Healthy Environment and its role in public health was discussed with Participants of DEWS refresher training in District Hangu. Past experience of the same and other districts regarding inputs in steps towards healthy environment and its outcome was shared with the forum.

### **Nutrition:**

- Coordination meeting with Deputy Chief HSRU regarding the inaugural meeting of Provincial Thematic Working Group of Nutrition. Issue agreed upon. Letter to be issued to Secretary Health this week.
- Orientation Refresher training on Facility based management of SAM done in Satellite Hospital Pabbi, Nowshera. Four Nurses and 2 Doctors were in attendance. MS of the hospital emphasized on a full training course for the participants to maximize the output.
- Monitoring and evaluation visit conducted to district Kohat. Nutrition Surveillance system in the sentinel site of Usterzai and Lachii monitored. Issues regarding stationary discussed with District Coordinator and resolved with mutual consent.
- Monitoring visit of Nutrition Stabilization Center Kohat conducted. Operational issues regarding the NSC discussed with MS and Paediatrician. Understanding on resolving the issues with mutual cooperation achieved.
- Coordination meeting held with UNHCR focal person for trainings. Nominations from UNHCR IPs requested. Response awaited from UNHCR.
- Coordination meeting conducted with a Consultant regarding the updating of Support materials for the Facility based management of SAM. Concept note will be submitted next week & more meetings planned next week.
- Meeting held with APC National Program for Family Planning & PHC regarding ToT for HANSS. Nominations requested and a meeting planned this week.
- Similar meeting with Deputy Director Nutrition regarding nominations for ToT regarding Facility based management of SAM. Nominations requested for the ToT and meeting planned this week where operational issues regarding the ToT will be discussed..
- Total of 19 patients were admitted in 4 Nutrition Stabilization Center with 13 discharged after treatment.

### **District level coordination & monitoring:**

**Swat:** DPEC Meeting held at DCO Swat's Office on upcoming SNID to be conducted in Mingora City and a total of 9 UCs covered. Team trainings were completed. Monitoring visit to THQ Matta, BHU Sher Palam, RHC Chuprial and BHU Rahat Kot.

**Shangla:** Visit to 2 BHU's (BHU Damorai and BHU Olander) and 2 CD's (CD Kotkay and CD Shang) and one THQ (THQ Besham) for eDEWS and CRP registers along with OPD registers counter checking. Meeting with THQ Besham on water shortage in the health facility was held. Meeting was held with EDOH on EPI reforms considering current poor EPI coverage. Meeting conducted with ACO Shangla on the upcoming district coordination meeting. Meeting held with DSM PPHI on late eDEWS from BHU Gunahgar and BHU Kabalgram. Meeting conducted with EPI Logistic officer on mass vaccination and approval of measles vaccines provision.

**Swabi:** DPEC meeting attended at DCO office Swabi. Coordination meetings with MS of both hospitals-recipients of WHO SFD donated equipment conducted on details of the distribution plan. MRM held at PPHI for 40 MO/MT. WHO presented the national emergency plan for polio eradication to the participants.

**Lower Dir:** Coordination meetings held with EDOH, EPI coordinator, MS Smarbagh, MS DHQ, BHU Tormang, RHC Mayar, AR Timar Camp, MCH Khal, RHC Talash, THQ Chakdara, ARI Centre Chakdara and TMA chief officer on various aspects including leishmaniasis and measles alerts response.

**Kohistan:** Visit conducted to ARI centers Dassu and Pattan. A visit was made to RHC Pattan, RHC Dassu, BHU Jijal and RHC Ranolia. Meeting held with Malteser International on upcoming closure of PHC

component of its project by 31<sup>st</sup> March at one RHC and five BHUs. Meeting conducted with CWS P/A phasing out from Kohistan (three RHCs and two BHUs).

**Nowshera:** The security situation of the district was disturbed by a bomb blast outside a ruling party rally killing 7 and injuring 39 people. WHO supported DHQ Nowshera by providing emergency medicines. Coordination meeting held with DSM, PPHI Nowshera on timely reporting of alerts by PPHI, assignment of a focal Person for timely submission of eDEWS, and proposed training for district staff. Coordination meeting held with EPI coordinator on sharing data of vaccinated children in response to measles alerts and measles mass vaccination. Monitoring visits conducted to CD Zando Banda and CD Khat Kalay. On job capacity building done. Three cases of dog bite reported from CD Misri Banda. Immediate arrangement of ARV being done by WHO. 7 cases of measles and 10 cases of leishmaniasis were reported. A training will be organized for LHW of Dak Ismail Khel. At present IRC, Islamic Relief, CAMP, CESST, Johaniter and Flowers Organizations supporting DoH and PPHI activities.

**Upper Dir:** A coordination meeting with DSM, PPHI conducted on nominations of focal points for all BHUs for reporting of eDEWS on regular basis. Coordination meeting with EDO-H and National coordinator for LHWs regarding health & hygiene sessions in UC Darora and UC Darikand after receiving alerts of measles. Coordination meeting with EDO-H and M.S DHQ Hospital held at DHQ Hospital Dir Upper for installation of SFD equipment provided by WHO and for set up of one WHO funded EDOH warehouse at DHQ. WHO conducted monitoring visits of RHC Bibyawar, BHU Darora and RHC Barawal banda and on job training on eDEWS was provided to health staff of RHC Bibyawar.
